

Fine Night For Racing

Other than a few puddles laying around, you'd never know the track had just come out of week of rain. The rain stopped Friday and sunshine Saturday evaporated all but the worst of the puddles.

The cars, which have not seen any practice time in weeks, rolled in through the afternoon and by 5:30 so too were the fans. The weather forgotten, everyone only had racing on their minds.

The schedule for the night had been expanded, adding in the rained out May 29 SKL Trailers Pro Truck race. The trucks were scheduled to race in Regina Saturday night, but rain there changed those plans. Competition Director Cliff Pompu says the trucks were ready and the drivers were ready, so it made sense to run the make-up race now, even given the short notice.

In the main feature of the night, the WSSL Auto Parts Super Late Model 40, Greg Vangool finally found gold in the 77 Signs Impala, after settling for second in the heat and qualifier. Trent Seidel brought the LA Weightloss Centres Impala across in second and Jim Gaunt was third in his Sky Financial Mortgage Machine Ford Fusion.

In the Cooper Tire Thunder Stock feature, Barry Stefaniuk's Led Sled Impala was first to the checkered flag, followed by the Rea Bros Racing Monte Carlo and Tristan Ransom's Caprice.

After receiving a mechanical flag in the qualifier for a fuel leak, Ken Ross piloted the Grace Beyer RE/Max Toyota Tundra for the

SKL Trailers Pro Truck 35 feature win. Scott Lucas was second in the Eskes Seal Coating Dodge Ram and Alex Leschenko was third in the "FAST" Dodge Ram. Tony Mikulcik, out for the first time this year after once again chased from the fields by rain, turned in a respectable fourth place finish in the feature after tenth and ninth place finishes earlier in the evening.

The Budget Car and Truck Rental street stock feature doubled as the Wes Skakun memorial, with the trophy being presented by Heather Skakun.

Mike Schroeder becomes the fourth name on the trophy, having wrestled the feature win from Aaron Anderson's Kel-Cor Racing Dodge Demon. Darryl Potts was third in "Sally", his Ford Mustang. Adam Yelland was fourth and Todd Pluhator was fifth. The win was Schroeder's second win of the night, having picked up the checkered flag in the qualifier

Bad Boys, Bad Boys

One would have thought it was a full moon night Saturday as the black flag was seen quite often. Besides warnings given several times, Aaron Anderson was given a full black flag disqualification on the final lap of the Budget Car and Truck Rental heat race. Coming through corner three he got into race leader Adam Yelland, spinning him into the grass infield and out of the race.

Later, in post race technical inspections after the WSSL Auto Parts Super Late Model feature, second place finisher Trent Seidel was issued a technical disqualification when his LA Weight Loss Centres Impala failed a ground clearance rule. The SLM rules state "Side Panel of body MUST have 2" minimum ground clearance." The tech 'go/no go' tool did not pass under the side panel when checked. The DQ has cost Seidel in the points, dropping him back to fourth place. Jim Gaunt, Glen Hertzke and Greg Vangool are currently in a first place tie at 91 points.



Late Models Parked

Three WSSL Auto Parts super late models didn't hit the track on Saturday for various reasons. It is suspected the new #38 Proline Motorsport Fusion of Dave Bone blew a head gasket in practice, while the #09 Impala of Dave Bone has some electrical problems and wouldn't start. Newly registered Howard Crossman and his #56 Impala had a scheduling conflict when rain forced the date change. All expect to be out in two weeks for the premiere of the Dakota Dunes Western Canada SLM Championship Series.
